THE LIFE CHALLENGE

CONNECT

Discuss what it means to be taken captive by something. How does it alter your life or how does it direct you in making decisions?

IDENTITY

Do you ever think about what captures your heart? Paul in this passage is comparing empty philosophies, high-sounding nonsense, human thinking, and spiritual powers of this world to the Fullness of Jesus. What are some examples you see in your world today? Where does the exclusivity of Christ challenge today's world? (See Acts 4:10-12)

THE EXAMEN

What captures your heart? Discuss how you view your faith from the three aspects of Orthodoxy (right beliefs), Orthopraxy (correct practices), & Orthopathy (the heart of God). Does this marriage of all three views of faith challenge you in any way? How does this help explain the fullness of Christ?

PRACTICE

Where are you in your practice of being an apprentice of Jesus and experiencing his fullness? Is there a key takeaway from this discussion you want to explore more? What is it and what's your plan of action?

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray for each other in what has been shared. Pray to give praise and thanks to God for his fullness and complete work he has done. If possible, play a worship song and allow the praise to fill your heart.
