CONNECT

Dead or Alive

Numb. Playing the church game.

In-Debt or Free

Shame never ends.

Never good enough for God.

Captive or Victor

Battle with addiction, powers, lies or old thinking.

PRACTICE

After the encouragement of verses 6 & 7, Paul gives a caution: "See to it that no one takes you captive". The truths Paul proclaims in the verses that follow are critical for our battle. What is a practice you do (or could start) that would daily remind you of these powerful truths from Scripture?
